Class Pricing:

Adult ~ \$45 per class (\$40 per class for 2 or more when prepaid by August 1st)

Youth ~ \$40 per class (\$35 per class for 2 or more when prepaid by August 1st)

Gamblers Choice Class:

This class is \$50 per rider & has a 50% pay out to top rider.

Grounds Fees:

\$10 Per horse on the grounds (Waived if Prepaid by August 1st)

Camping:

Camping is \$15 per trailer (waived if prepaid for classes by August 1st)

Practice Day:

Only \$25 per rider all day.

Come Wed to practice all day or stay the night for the challenges for the next few days! Gates Open 11am Wednesday.

Any day you have a horse on the grounds and not showing that day will be \$25 per rider.

Tie Lines available at each parking space. Water for horses

Ribbons for 1st - 6th placing's.

Directions:

From Rt 77~ @ Rt 77 & Rt 30, head East on Rt 30. Go to 2nd exit, Waynesburg/Rt 43 head south. Take this all the way down till you are almost to Downtown Waynesburg. Turn Right on Elson St (there will be a park sign and a sign for West End Pizza at Elson). Elson will dead end into the Park entrance. For IMTCA members, this is a IMTCA Regional Challenge. To Qualify for IMTCA Regional's, you need to participate in 2 Approved Regional Qualifying Challenges, See website for Approved Locations. Earn IMTCA Midwest High Points as well at this show.

Judge's decisions are FINAL. Unsportsman like conduct is grounds for dismissal and forfeiture of all fees and entries paid. Creek Side Horse Park, OQHA or IMTCA are Not responsible for damages or injury to exhibitors, animals, spectators, or personal property. No refunds will be given.

To be eligible for year end OQHA awards & IMTCA Regional's you must be a member.

40% payback on all classes with 10 entries or more. 20% payback on all classes with 5-9 entries. Less than 4 or less entries will only have added monies. All paybacks will be for 1st 50%, 2nd 30% and 3rd 20%. Added monies are added to each class totaling \$1500. Bronze Horses for 1st place in classes 1 - 29.

Levels:
Lead Line: Rider on the ground, horse on line with a person in the saddle
Novice: Walking over obstacles/lesser degree of difficulty than Level 1
Level 1: Training, Walk only, in hand or riding
Level 2: Intermediate, Walk and trot, in hand & riding. 180 & 360 degree turns on some obstacles.
Level 3: Masters, walk, trot and canter, 180 & 360 degree turns on some obstacles.

Divisions:
Novice: Limited exposure to mastering Mountain Trail obstacles. No more than 3 blue ribbons in a qualifying Trail Challenge or in the first 2 years of riding horse.
Youth: Any rider under 18 years of age.
Adult: 18 Years of age and over.
Open: All Riders Qualified except for Novice.
Trainers: Any rider who is paid to give lessons, can only go in OPEN Classes.
Junior Horse: Horses 5 years and under (this is an Open class)

Fun Classes:
Ride One Lead One: Ride one horse and lead other horse through patterns for both horses
Rider with Dog: Pattern for each rider and dog, specific commands for the dog. Dog & horse each receive points.
Gamblers Choice: The rules are different. You have 2 minutes to show your skills. Navigating the obstacles is all that counts. However; if a horse steps out with just one foot the obstacle does not count for a score. Each obstacle has a value which is given when show starts. You must be back at start line when the 2 minutes are up or the score does not count.

Within each Division, a rider can choose to Levels, In Hand or Riding, or both. See restrictions for Divisions within each box below.

Novice Riders may not ride in any Level 3, Money or Open Classes

Each Rider/Horse Combo can enter up to 2 Levels. Level 1 & 2 or Level 2 & 3
